**Responsibilities:**

- Read drawings, specifications, and work orders (both paper and electronic) to assess work required and to measure and layout work to restore, install or repair concrete.
- Ensure adequate supplies of tools, equipment, and materials at the site.
- Assemble and set formwork to required pitch, depth, and alignment.
- Install items such as vapor barrier, reinforcement, and expansion joints, when needed.
- Help position concrete trucks for placing.
- Place and finish concrete, utilizing power buggies, laser screeds, troweling machines, bull floats and hand trowels.
- Verify the line and grade of concrete finishing work to ensure specifications are met.
- Apply hardening and sealing compounds to cure waterproof and restore surfaces.
- Monitor the effects of weather on curing throughout the finishing process and cover/barricade as needed.
- Work with laborers to strip, clean, and stack forms; clean-up work area and load/unload equipment and supplies.
- Additional duties, as may be required.

**Qualifications:**

- 2+ years of concrete finishing experience, or completion of a 3-year apprenticeship training through Local 633 Cement Masons & Plasters Union (or equal experience).
- Have a valid driver license.
- Be able to reliably travel to and from the jobsite that could be over 90 miles from home.
- Ability to work at heights over 6 feet.
- OSHA 30 certification or the willingness to be enrolled in training to achieve it.
- Lift up to 75 pounds.
- ACI Certification is a plus.
